Camp will be held at Tausch Farms in Iowa. Campers are under supervision at all time. They will be staying at the bunk house on Tausch Farms.

When the campers first arrive at camp they pick out a calf. Calves are from 4 - 5 months of age and have been tied up for three or four days. One segment deals with hair coat care and how to grow and clip hair on cattle. They wind up the week with a showmanship contest. We are not out to pick a winner but to help critique what each camper has learned.

We teach campers basic cattle care, stressing showmanship doesn't start at the fair. They get a quick lesson on feeding and transportation of cattle.

One day is spent at Hawkeve Breeders bull stud and talk about the importance of presentation of cattle to potential buyers. More than anything else, the campers get hands on experience preparing cattle for show

The campers need only bring a willingness to learn, Tausch Farms provides the cattle, equipment, and meals.
